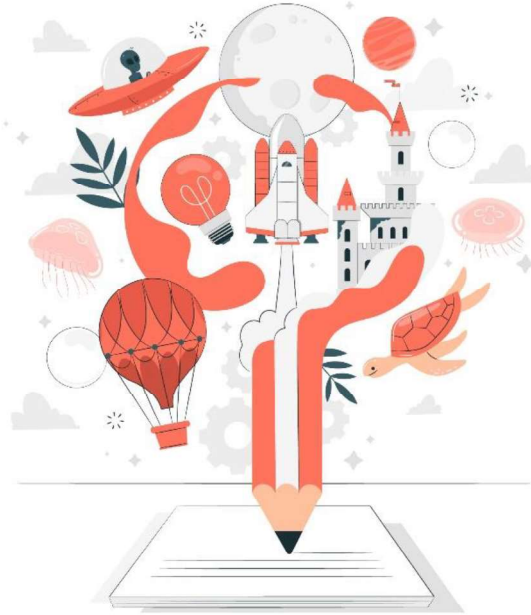
Write an acrostic poem, using a key-word related to the topic of your “You Tell” story!
